Foolishly unaware that reality isn't so trustworthy

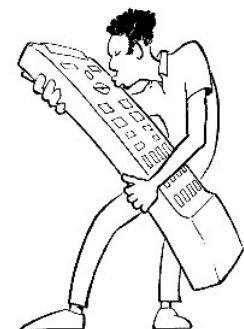
### REMOTES
